Missionaries of the Month: May 2023

Toby and Sara Shannon - Commission to Every Nation (US, Peru; Worldwide)

Ministry Updates:

- o The missionary counseling network will soon complete its 2nd year of ministry to missionaries and relief workers worldwide. (See Prayer)
- o Our Yapey teams (Yapey Yurijcuna/Renacer Ministry in Peru) continue to plant seeds of the Kingdom of God in hearts of our participants with disabilities, while bringing them training to help them survive in this life and support, or contribute to the economy of, their families. May they understand that their limitations are temporary and yearn for the glorious Day of the Lord!
- o God continues to amaze us at how He is moving in the hearts of riders and authorities of the motorcycle racing events. Much prayer is going forth weekly, that hearts would be reached for the Gospel and that family relationships would be restored. Our ministry team is led by a national pastor/racer who is highly respected by all in the motorcycle-racing world.
- o There are 3 planned work team dates for volunteers to come and help build the training and discipleship center for the ministry to people with disabilities in Huánuco State (where more than 35,000 are registered with disabilities) in 2023. The first work team of five adults (in March despite it being rainy season) was able to prefabricate (in our shop welding shop) all the exterior wall panels for the construction! The second team (in July) will be a youth team coming to begin raising the walls on site and doing Paralympic camp with some of our participants. The third team (in October) is open for all (even those unskilled in building) who wish to come to Peru to help finish the construction of the first building! One missionary family who played an important part in starting the church is moving to a new ministry. Two of our key Japanese partners who also played important parts from the beginning are less available due to changes in their life circumstances. Pray that the members of SUGC would willingly and zealously serve in the activities of the church as we seek to implement new structures, which encourage a more proactive role for members.

Welcome and Announcements

Responsive Call to Worship – Isaiah 53:11-54:10

Leader: Out of the anguish of his soul he shall see and be satisfied; by his knowledge shall the righteous one, my servant, make many to be accounted righteous, and he shall bear their iniquities. ¹² Therefore I will divide him a portion with the many, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong, because he poured out his soul to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he bore the sin of many, and makes intercession for the transgressors.

All: “Sing, O barren one, who did not bear; break forth into singing and cry aloud, you who have not been in labor! For the children of the desolate one will be more than the children of her who is married,” says the LORD. ² “Enlarge the place of your tent, and let the curtains of your habitations be stretched out; do not hold back; lengthen your cords and strengthen your stakes. ³ For you will spread abroad to the right and to the left, and your offspring will possess the nations and will people the desolate cities.

Leader: “Fear not, for you will not be ashamed; be not confounded, for you will not be disgraced; for you will forget the shame of your youth, and the reproach of your widowhood you will remember no more. ⁵ For your Maker is your husband, the Lord of hosts is his name; and the Holy One of Israel is your Redeemer, the God of the whole earth he is called. ⁶ For the LORD has called you like a wife deserted and

grieved in spirit, like a wife of youth when she is cast off, says your God. ⁷ For a brief moment I deserted you, but with great compassion, I will gather you. ⁸ In overflowing anger for a moment I hid my face from you, but with everlasting love I will have compassion on you,” says the LORD, your Redeemer. ⁹ “This is like the days of Noah to me: as I swore that the waters of Noah should no more go over the earth, so I have sworn that I will not be angry with you, and will not rebuke you. ¹⁰ For the mountains may depart and the hills be removed, but my steadfast love shall not depart from you, and my covenant of peace shall not be removed,” says the LORD, who has compassion on you.

Responsive Scripture Reading – Isaiah 61:10-62:5

Leader: I will greatly rejoice in the LORD; my soul shall exult in my God, for he has clothed me with the garments of salvation; he has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself like a priest with a beautiful headdress, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.

All: For as the earth brings forth its sprouts, and as a garden causes what is sown in it to sprout up, so the Lord GOD will cause righteousness and praise to sprout up before all the nations.

Leader: For Zion's sake I will not keep silent, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not be quiet, until her righteousness goes forth as brightness, and her salvation as a burning torch. ² The nations shall see your righteousness, and all the kings your glory, and you shall be called by a new name that the mouth of the LORD will give. ³ You shall be a crown of beauty in the hand of the LORD, and a royal diadem in the hand of your God. ⁴ You shall no more be termed Forsaken, and your land shall no more be termed Desolate, but you shall be called My Delight Is in Her, and your land Married; for the LORD delights in you, and your land shall be married. ⁵ For as a young man marries a young woman, so shall your sons marry you, and as the bridegroom rejoices over the bride, so shall your God rejoice over you.

Responsive Scripture Reading – Revelation 19:1-9

Leader: After this I heard what seemed to be the loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, crying out,

All: “Hallelujah! Salvation and glory and power belong to our God, for his judgments are true and just; for he has judged the great prostitute who corrupted the earth with her immorality, and has avenged on her the blood of his servants.” ³Once more they cried out, “Hallelujah! The smoke from her goes up forever and ever.”

Leader: And the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God who was seated on the throne, saying, “Amen. Hallelujah!” ⁵And from the throne came a voice saying, “Praise our God, all you his servants, you who fear him, small and great.” ⁶ Then I heard what seemed to be the voice of a great multitude, like the roar of many waters and like the sound of mighty peals of thunder, crying out,

All: “Hallelujah! For the Lord our God the Almighty reigns. ⁷ Let us rejoice and exult and give him the glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and his Bride has made herself ready;

Leader: it was granted her to clothe herself with fine linen, bright and pure”— for the fine linen is the righteous deeds of the saints. ⁹ And the angel said to me, “Write this: Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb.” And he said to me, “These are the true words of God.”

Scripture Reading – Mark 10:1-12

And he left there and went to the region of Judea and beyond the Jordan, and crowds gathered to him again. And again, as was his custom, he taught them. ² And Pharisees came up and in order to test him asked, “Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife?” ³ He answered them, “What did Moses command you?” ⁴ They said, “Moses allowed a man to write a certificate of divorce and to send her away.” ⁵ And Jesus said to them, “Because of your hardness of heart he wrote you this commandment. ⁶ But from the beginning of creation, ‘God made them male and female.’ ⁷ ‘Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, ⁸ and the two shall become one flesh.’ So they are no longer two but one flesh. ⁹ What therefore God has joined together, let not man separate.” ¹⁰ And in the house the disciples asked him again about this matter. ¹¹ And he said to them, “Whoever divorces his wife and marries another commits adultery against her, ¹² and if she divorces her husband and marries another, she commits adultery.”
